RE: 2024 Accommodation Charges: Long Term Care Facilities

Residents in Designated Supportive Living and Long-Term Care pay an accommodation charge to cover the cost of accommodation-related services such as rooms, meals, housekeeping and routine building maintenance. The *Nursing Homes Operation Regulation* and Ministerial Directive prescribes the maximum amount Operators can charge Long-Term Care Residents based on room type.

The maximum accommodation charge will be increased August 1, 2024 based on the Alberta Consumer Price Index.

Projected charges as of August 1, 2024 (based on 3.8%)

Room Type	Daily	Adjustment	Avg. Monthly	Adjustment
Private room	\$77.80	\$2.85/day	\$2,366	\$86/mo.
Semi-private	\$67.30	\$2.45/day	\$2,047	\$74/mo.

Government income supports related to accommodation charges will continue to be available to eligible low-income clients.
